These approvals are also subject to the fees described in Section 6.6.
- 2. Fences were specifically brought up in this meeting as well. These are covered in Section 6.13. We have a unique community, and we naturally want everyone to construct a fence on their property as they wish, however, we need to approve any fence design to assure it follows an acceptable style for our community.
