 - Revised FY 2013 budget

 - Only one person in neighborhood has responded to offer to have wood

- Locks on gates have been replaced appear to have been removed by PUD or county for entry to trim trees

 - Road probably not open anytime soon
- 8) Discussed homeowners not eligible to vote on budget at financials meeting
- 9) Discussed letters sent to past due homeowners and status of those turned over to collection agency
- 10) Discussed additional delinquent homeowners to be turned over to collection agency
- 11) Discussed pond work and maintenance free landscaping plan
 - Lower bid received
 - i) Lower areas Rock in place
 - ii) Other areas to be cleaned up and dirt removed and used as fill throughout HOA property or requesting homeowners
 - Use 2 inch river rock and getting finished neatly
 - When completed we can re-bid landscaping contract to 3 times a year
 - Additional issues and plan from previous landscaper
 - Money not being spent on 6 months of maintaining old landscaping will pay for much of the new maintenance free landscaping
 - Specific bid to accept and cost reduction benefits
 - By end of February would like to have greater dollar reserves and eliminate further costs

- 13) Discussed 30-day notice clause in landscaper contract and Anne Marie's contract
 - Typical 1-year contracts are generally for larger HOA's

- Homeowner had previously committed to become compliant before year end (2012)
- Homeowner had previously committed to pay dues owed before year end (2012) and has not

15) Discussed dog complaints

- Animal control has visited a specific homeowner based on complaints to county filed by neighbors
- Nuisance and dangerous dogs specific homeowners are afraid to let children play in yard because of neighbors dogs
- 16) Discussed additional concerns with violations and next steps for dealing with them
- 17) Discussed what to cover at annual meeting
 - Boards plans to address non-compliance issues
 - We have reduced every year since past high year
 - Plan to reduce costs further
 - i) After landscaping, Anne Marie's service is next most expensive budget item
 - (1) Eliminating would require additional volunteers to pick up administrate duties
 - Consistent nice look throughout neighborhood helps to boost property values
 - Why utilities bill went up over last year
 - i) Waterfall has run constantly after upgrades and not shut down for winter based on contractor recommendations
 - ii) If there was a rate change
 - iii) Still believe we have lower costs based on multiyear comparison
 - Overall goal is to reduce assessment every year
